The Recruit above-named was cautioned by me that if he made any false answer to any of the foregoing questions he would be liable to be punished. The foregoing questions were then read to the Recruit in my presence. I have taken care that he understands each question, and that his answer to each question has been duly entered as required to, and the said Recruit has made and signed the declaration and oath before me at on this 31 day of May 1881.

If any alteration is required on this page of the Attestation, the Officer who attested the Recruit, or a Justice of the Peace, should be requested to make it and initial the alteration under Section 80 (c), Army Act, 1881. The Recruit should, if he require it, receive a copy of the Declaration on Army Form E. 504.

He can see at the required distance with either eye, his heart and lungs are healthy, he has the free use of his joints and limbs, and he declares he is not subject to fits of any description.
