What is the Name and Residence of your present (or former) Master? 10. Are you Single, Married, or a Widower? 11. If Married, or a Widower, how many Children have you under 14 years of age? 12. Have you ever been sentenced to Penal Servitude? 13. Have you ever been discharged from any part of Her Majesty's Forces with Ignominy, or as Incurable and Worthless, or on account of conviction of felony, or of a sentence of penal servitude or have you been dismissed with disgrace from the Navy? 14. Do you now belong to, or have you ever served in, any Regiment, Brigade, or Corps in Her Majesty's Army or in the Army Reserve? 15. Do you now belong to, or have you ever served in, the Marines? 16. Do you now belong to, or have you ever served in, the Militia, or Militia Reserve? 17. Do you now belong to, or have you ever served in, the Royal Navy? 18. Do you now belong to the Volunteers, or to the Naval Artillery Volunteers, or to the Royal Naval Reserve Force? 19. Have you truly stated the whole, if any, of your previous Service? 20. Are you in receipt of a pension for any such Service? 21. Have you ever been rejected as unfit for Her Majesty's Service? 22. Did you receive a Notice, and do you understand its meaning? 23. Who gave you the Notice? 24. Are you willing to be attested for the term of four years (provided Her Majesty should so long require your services), as a Militiaman for the County of ...

He can see at the required distance with either eye, his heart and lungs are healthy, he has the free use of his joints and limbs, and he declares he is not subject to fits of any description.
